Hiroiyuki Sanada to star in 'Fallen Moon'



Hiroiyuki Sanada (“The Last Samurai,” “Rush Hour 3”) is set to star in the noir-crime drama “Fallen Moon,” the tale of a New York City detective investigating the murder of his long-alienated daughter. **Peter Medak** (“The Krays,” “Romeo Is Bleeding”) is directing the feature. **Geoff Tate**, lead vocalist of the legendary rock band **Queensrÿche**, has signed on to compose the film score.

Sanada, star of the acclaimed Oscar nominated film, “Tasogare Seibei” (aka “The Twilight Samurai”), is slated to play Moto, a Japanese-born detective in the NYPD whose daughter is brutally murdered sparking a chain of life-changing events. Through a series of entwined story lines, Moto comes face-to-face with the world that stole his daughter from him.

The Do-Over Productions film is from an original screenplay written by **Jarrold Feliciano** and **Mirjana Novkovic**. Feliciano, Novkovic and **Valerie McCaffrey** are producing with **Roger Pugliese** co-producing. Sanada is repped by **Management 360**.
